Our amazing School Council will be visiting City Hall in Bradford.




# Year 6 Residential - Boggle Hole Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> - 5<sup>th</sup> June

#### **Attendance**

We would like to thank you for your continued support in attendance and arriving at school on time. Currently our attendance is 95.1%, which is just below our target for whole school of 96%, so we need your support to ensure your child/ren are in school every day.

Regular attendance at school is vitally important. Please contact school as soon as possible if your child is absent either via telephone (01274 678386) or by emailing the office. Can we politely remind parents that holidays will not be authorised in term time. Where families take one or more periods of unauthorised leave, or a period of four or more weeks of leave are taken, Bradford Council will utilise the option to start legal proceedings via the magistrates' court, instead of issuing a penalty notice. This means that parents may be liable to receive a significantly higher fine (up to £2500 per child, per parent) if found guilty, as

well as receive a criminal record, which may be reportable to employers (for example, via a DBS Check). In rare circumstances, magistrates can consider a custodial sentence for up to 3 months.

# **Free School Meals**

Whilst we know that all children in Reception and Key Stage 1 are entitled to a free school meal – this is known as the Universal Free School Meal offer – it is very important that they, as well as the parents of any Key Stage 2 children, still register via the <u>Bradford Council Website</u> if you receive any of the following benefits:-



- Income Support
- Income Based Jobseekers Allowance
- Income Related Employment and Support Allowance
- Child Tax Credit with an annual income of less than £16,190, provided they are not receiving Working Tax Credit
- the 'Guaranteed' element of the State Pension Credit
- support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999 (you will need to apply directly to the school or call the Education Service on 01274 439393)
- Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)
- Universal Credit with an annual net earned income threshold of less than £7,400

If you do have entitlement to a free school meal, we can offer you a £25 voucher each July towards the purchase of a Hill Top winter coat, fleece or uniform.



#### **School Uniform**

At Hill Top we believe that wearing the correct school uniform develops a sense of belonging and pride. This also extends to our PE kits; therefore, could you please ensure that your children are wearing the correct PE kit. Children must wear navy or black tracksuit bottoms, a jade coloured t-shirt and a navy or black plain hoodie / sweatshirt or their school jumper and not branded sportswear. If your child attends P.E. days in school wearing branded items, they will be asked to change into spare PE kit that we keep in school. We do have a limited amount of (pre-loved) PE kit available in school for you to purchase for 50p. Thank you for your support.

For the warmer weather in Summer Term the children may wear blue or green and white gingham dresses or black or grey shorts with the relevant polo shirt.

#### IMPORTANT - PARKING.

I am extremely concerned about the illegal and dangerous parking, which almost caused one of our children to be knocked down at the end of term. I continue to receive complaints about parking every week, which causes a risk to children crossing the road and an inconvenience to our neighbours, in particular when parking across their driveways. It is completely unacceptable that this is happening to our children and our neighbours, by parents from our own school community. Consider the potential dangers to our children and do not ignore the parking restrictions outside school. These restrictions are in place for the safety of your children and the residents on Lower School Street and Common Road. Illegal parking and turning could have fatal and tragic consequences. We will

continue to work with the traffic wardens and report concerns. We often get a better response when our parents also report to them. Their number is 01274 431000 Option 8.
